This week long camp focuses on issues relevant to young people. It addresses challenges facing young people, including social justice and equality issues. The Solidarity Kid's Camp of Manitoba combines learning with cooperative activities and loads of guaranteed fun.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Young people between the ages of 10-15, who are sons and daughters of union members, are eligible to attend.



WHAT DOES IT COST?

Registration is \$300.00 per camper. Some affiliated unions subsidize this cost. **It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure this funding is in place, whether personal or subsidized.** A \$75 cheque for the deposit is required with your returned registration form. It will be returned to you, un-cashed, when you drop your child(ren) off at camp.

CANCELLATION POLICY

The cancellation policy is three (3) weeks prior to camp. If you do not give three weeks notice, or do not show up to camp then your deposit cheque will not be returned to you.



DETAILS

The camp will begin on Sunday, August 18th and runs through until camp closing on Saturday, August 24th.

Staff at our camp includes group counsellors/advisors, a camp nurse, camp director, and lifeguard, who will be in attendance at all times.



TIMELINES AND STUFF

Parents/Guardians should drop off campers between 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on August 18th but NO EARLIER than 2:00 p.m.

Pick-up on the 24th should be between noon and 2:00 p.m. but NO LATER than 2:00 p.m. Parents are invited to stay for the BBQ at noon.

Camp leaders will be present with campers at all times. Our ratio is five (5) campers to one (1) adult.
