

This week long camp focuses on issues relevant to young people. It addresses challenges which include social justice and equality issues. The Solidarity Kids' Camp of Manitoba combines learning with cooperative activities and loads of guaranteed fun.

WHO CAN ATTEND AND WHAT DOES IT COST?

Young people between the ages of 11-15, who are sons and daughters of union members, are eligible to attend.

Registration is **\$350.00 per camper**. Some affiliated unions subsidize this cost. **It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure this funding is in place, whether personal or subsidized. Your full registration fee is required by the deadline date.**

CANCELLATION POLICY

Full refund if cancellation notice is received by August 1. After that date a \$100 cancellation fee will apply. No refunds will be available if cancellation is received on or after August 15, 2014.



DETAILS

The camp will begin on Sunday, August 17 and runs through until camp closing on Friday, August 22.

This camp includes all appropriate and necessary staff to ensure our campers have a safe, educational and fun time.

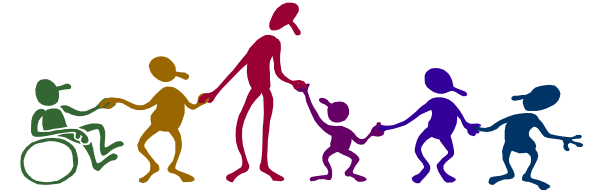
AFTERNOONS
