More than **1,600** Parks Canada employees were told April 30 that they could lose their jobs. This includes:

- the people who maintain the place you're visiting now
- biologists, and naturalists who monitor the health of Parks ecology
- interpreters, and guides who provide the programming that bring Canada's parks, canals and historical sites to life
- conservationists who protect both the people and wildlife in Canada's national parks.

Some sites may be closed. Other sites and parks will see their hours cut, their seasons shortened and their services reduced.

Parks, canals and historical sites are an essential part of our history and national heritage. They've been recognized internationally as some of the world's most beautiful and historically important places.
